



AHI TOURNAMENT
& 'OHANALAULE'A

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All boats must check in with team number and pass inspection before launch. (No fish of any kind allowed on or in boat for 1st and 2nd day, all coolers open)
2. 3am-4am harbor opens for non-trailer boat inspections / 4am harbor opens to all trailer boats
3. Please follow designated routes for entering and exiting boat ramps.
4. Boats in the water must stay within Pokai Bay and the high school while waiting, cannot pass official boat until 5:30am
5. Kick-off radio station channel 10 (only for start time)
6. Tournament Start Time 5:30am
7. All types of fishing are acceptable - live bait (must be caught during tournament hours), trolling, green stick, etc.
8. ALL fish caught must be documented by proof of video with team card and catch. (There will be a separate card for each day).
9. All fish must be caught under your own power.
10. You must make it back under own power for your fish to qualify
11. Team cards need to be turned in at weigh station in order to weigh fish.
12. 2nd team card will be issued at weigh station.
13. All Ahi must be at a minimum of 100lbs to qualify. All Ahi needs to be gut and gilled, no sperm sack and/or eggs.
14. Aku, Ono, & Mahi Mahi need to be 15lbs minimum to qualify. (Gut and gilled NOT required)
15. Tournament Finish Time – 1st day: 4:59pm
16. Tournament Finish Time – 2nd day: 3:59pm
17. ALL BOATS must check in before end time to qualify. Official referee will be on the pier to time-stamp all boats.
18. Once harbor gets packed close to end fishing time, All boats once checked in will be redirected back out to allow other boats to check in.
19. All fish will be inspected - video or picture must be shown (Team Card must be displayed in video/picture, as well) before weighed.
20. All fish weighed on the first day will have tails clipped.
21. Non-trailer boats must provide own transportation to weigh fish.
22. In the event of a tie between two boats, first to check in to the harbor wins.
23. One winning category per boat between all fish PER DAY. (Except total weight pot)
24. All persons or captains must be present to receive prizes.
25. Wash Station Will Be Closed During Weigh-ins
26. Mandatory to contact home base if in distress/ tow vessel will be on standby.
27. Tournament fees will be reimbursed to any one captain that assists in the event of an emergency and or tow vessel not able to reach in time.
28. Automatic disqualification for any captain or crew who doesn't follow tournament rules.
29. Last but not least: HAVE FUN, respect the tournament, respect the community, and respect each other.
